

HIGH SCHOOL BASEBALL – 4.16.21 & 4.17.21

Event Rule's & Guidelines:

Arrival

- **Bus Parking:** Team buses are able to be parked at no charge along North Shore Drive (McFadden's and Hyde Park are located on this street)
- **24 Hour Security:** All teams, coaches, umpires, team photographer and PA Announcer should enter at 24 Hour Security 45 minutes prior to their scheduled game time.
 - All players, coaches and umpires must arrive dressed in uniforms
 - Upon entry into 24 Hours Security everyone will undergo a screening/temperature check
 - Names of umpires, team photographer and PA Announcer need to be submitted by Thursday, April 15th
 - Masks are required the entire time while at PNC PARK
- **Home Plate Gate:** All spectators will enter at the Home Plate Gate, located at the corner of Mazeroski Way and General Robinson. Spectators will be permitted to enter 30 minutes prior to their team's scheduled game time.
 - ***Concession stands*** will not be open, therefore spectators should bring their own snacks and beverages, which fall in line with PNC Park's outside food and beverage policy.
 - Spectators must abide by PNC Park's ***bag policy*** and bags bigger than 8" x 5" x 1" will not be permitted unless it is a medical or diaper bag.
 - ***Spectators will be permitted in the following lower bowl seating areas:***
 - Sections 1-12 or 21-32 and Sections 101-132
 - Spectators must sit in an open seat. Seat ties must not be removed. If there is a violation, this could cause for dismissal.
 - ***Restrooms*** will be open in the Crow's Nest Area of PNC Park, located behind sections 105-108.

Playing Field

- Teams will be permitted onto the field to warm-up 30 minutes prior to the game
- Protective Matting will be used around the mound and in coaches boxes (All Coaches must remain on Matting)
- No Infield warm-ups prior to the game and No Bullpen access for the entirety of the event. Warm-ups are to occur in the outfield ONLY.
- Coaches must coach from the warning track & umpires are to remain on the dirt
- Pitchers must remain on the mound to receive ball
- Please stay off edges of the grass playing field.
- Time Limit- 2 hours or 7 innings, whichever comes first
- Swinging bats on the Warning Track only
- NO celebrations permitted on the field
- Team Photo's / Photo's to be done on warning Track **ONLY**
- Teams are permitted in the dugouts
- Umpires will utilize the Visitor Dugout Swing Room
- Teams are permitted to use the Dugout Restrooms

MASKS/FACE COVERINGS:

- **ALL PERSONS INSIDE OF PNC PARK, INCLUSIVE OF PLAYERS, COACHES, SPECTATORS, ETC. MUST WEAR A MASK OR FACE COVERING AT ALL TIMES.**
- **ANYONE VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL BE SUBJECT TO REMOVAL FROM PNC PARK.**
- This is to keep everyone safe and is consistent with WPIAL guidelines: ***"Coaches, athletes (including cheerleaders), and spectators must wear face coverings if they cannot maintain sustained physical distance from persons outside of their household. This includes while actively engaged in workouts, competition, and on the sidelines, in the dugout, etc."***
